**Space Systems Command to host Media Roundtable focused on
Assured Access to Space & Space Mobility
Jan. 31 at 10 a.m. EST**

EL SEGUNDO, Calif. - Space Systems Command (SSC) will host a media roundtable focused on Assured Access to Space and Space Mobility on Wednesday, Jan. 31 at 10a.m. ET at the Orange County Convention Center in Orlando, Florida. The roundtable follows SSC and the U.S. Space Force's co-sponsored [Space Mobility Conference](#), which takes place on Jan. 30 as part of [SpaceCom](#), the global commercial space conference and exposition.

Brig. Gen. Kristin Panzenhagen, SSC Program Executive Officer for Assured Access to Space, along with members of her leadership team, will share information and respond to media questions concerning the current and future state of space mobility and logistics, including:

- Priorities and goals for fiscal year and calendar year 2024 as they relate to space mobility and logistics.
- Key advances in space mobility and logistics, including access and on-orbit capabilities.
- Emerging capabilities in on-orbit- servicing and refueling.
- Emerging capabilities in point-to-point delivery from or through space.
- Spaceport resiliency through global partnership.

In addition to leading SSC's Assured Access to Space, Brig. Gen. Panzenhagen serves as SSC's director of Launch and Range Operations, commander of Space Launch Delta 45, and director of the Eastern Range.
